Dogs are incredible friends to people, and they have been companions through centuries. The relationship between dogs and people is deep and old.

The friendship between dogs and people began 15,000 years ago when dogs followed people's migration throughout East Asia. The connection was natural because both people and dogs are social beings. Neither can succeed when alone, and both benefit mentally (and often physically) from strong social bonds.

Though domestic dogs share 99% of their DNA with wolves, dogs show warmth to other dogs and humans which contrasts greatly with a wolf's defensive reaction to others. Dogs are social animals that need attention and affection, making them a major nominee for a person's best friend. We can think of cats and other animal pets as a choice for people who love to have an animal as a pet, but pet owners have always preferred dogs for **their** protective nature and companionship. There are even recent researches that state 74% of people are dog lovers, whereas 21% of them like cats and other pets.

Dogs have proven themselves to be loyal, kind and understanding. They are able to greet us happily after what may have been the worst day of our lives and make us feel better when they shake their tails excitedly and jump around playfully. They are by our side when we are sick, sad, and lonely. They love us even when we are angry. Dogs are the ones which seem to understand us on a level that we even cannot understand.

Dogs are great assistants to sheep keepers and hunters; they have an acute sense of smell and **swift** feet to help hunters catch their prey. Dogs can help people who are trapped under buildings struck by earthquakes. Dogs help humans with day-to-day tasks, many of which may not be possible without them. Dogs also help prevent possible crimes and save lives. Often, dogs truly deserve their status as men's best friends.
