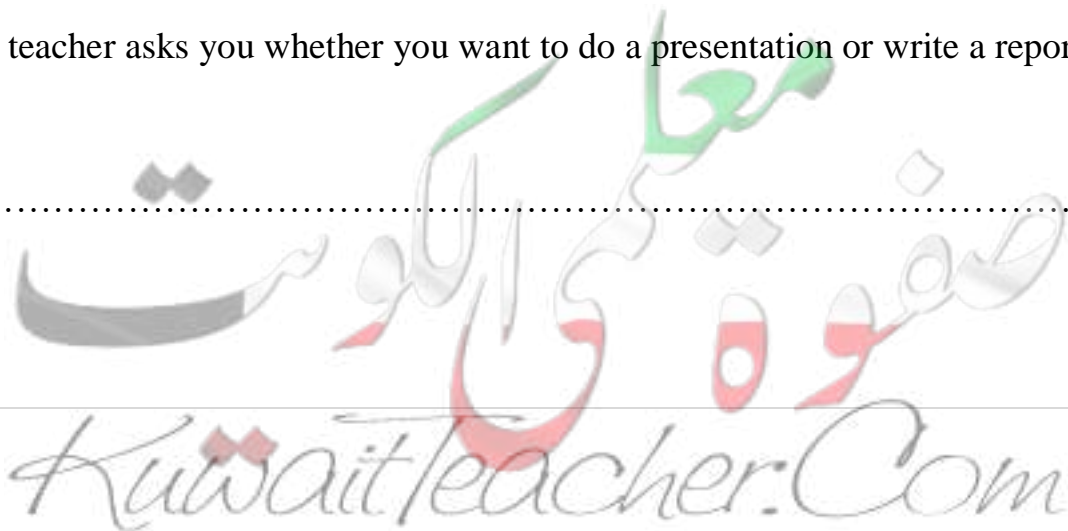

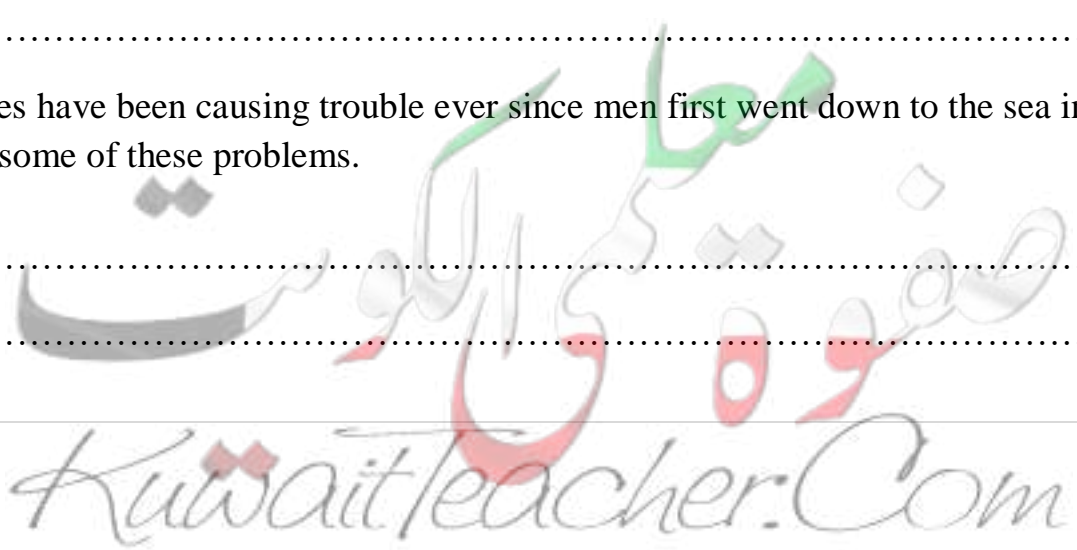

*** Read the following passage, then answer the questions below:**

Japanese people are more likely to reach 100 years old than anyone else in the world, a fact that some researchers attribute to their diet. The Japanese island of Okinawa alone has about 457 of people over the age of 100. **It** is considered to be the healthiest place in the world.

The Okinawans' secret lies in two things – their food, and their attitude towards life. As a happy group of people, the elders seem to have no signs of worry on their faces, stress seems to be a foreign concept to them. They hardly ever get angry. They enjoy life because they feel happy at work and they think that's the medicine for a long life. Most of the over-85-years-old elderly seem to be waiting to die, sick of dealing with their physical pains and of struggling to survive on small pensions, but not the Okinawans. They love life and they are full of energy.

The Okinawan eating habits are certainly worth a mention as well. Their regular diet is not based on red meat, but largely on rice, fish and vegetables. One of their popular dishes, Mimiga, is low in fat and high in calcium. They also eat plenty of tofu, and vegetables such as bitter gourd. They eat sweet potato which is especially **nutritious** ; it is said to contain large amount of beta carotene and Vitamin A.

Elderly Okinawans have among the lowest mortality rates in the world from a multitude of chronic diseases of aging and as a result enjoy not only what may be the world's longest life expectancy but the world's longest health expectancy. Centenarians, in particular, have a history of aging slowly and delaying or sometimes escaping the chronic diseases of aging including heart diseases and cancer.

Doing research on Okinawa's high life expectancy has been very motivating for researchers; it's great to know there are people in the world who have figured out the secret to a long and happy life.
