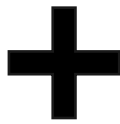

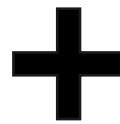

## Examples

**Regular verbs in the past end with (-ed):**  
EX: I visited ed my grandparents yesterday.  
**Irregular verbs change:**  
Ex: They went to a magic show last week.  
She had her lunch two hours ago.

**Negative: didn't + infinitive (V1)**  
I didn't go out last night.  
Ex: He didn't ..... to school yesterday.  
( come came - coming )

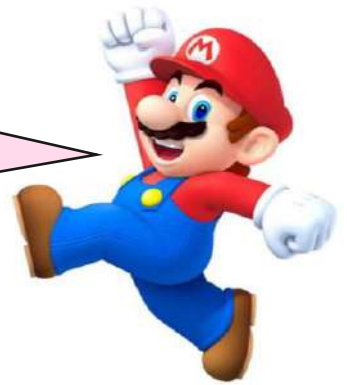

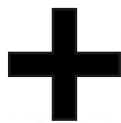
