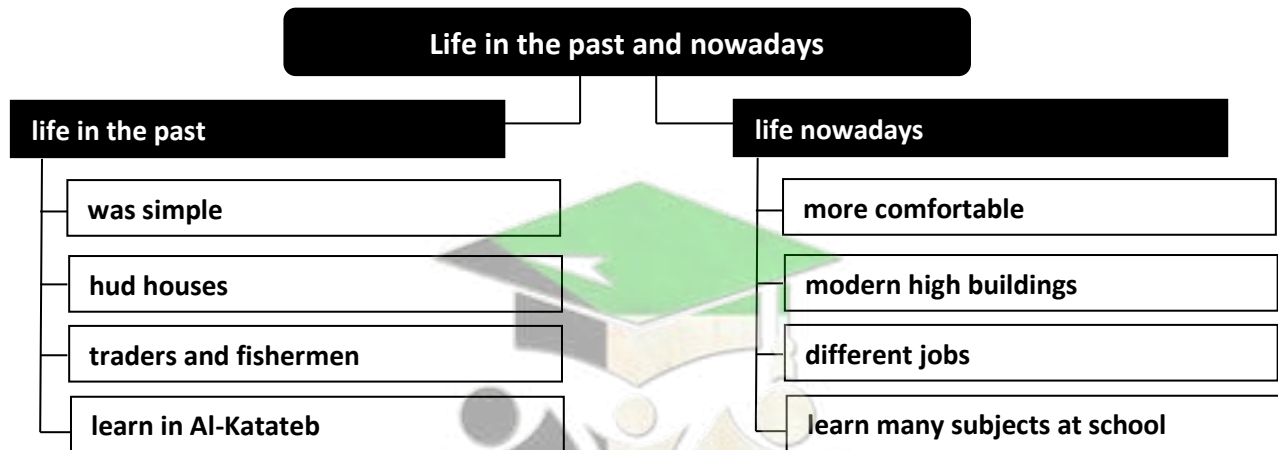
Astronauts travel to space in shuttles. They work and live in space. They explore the space. They float in the air. There is no gravity in the space.

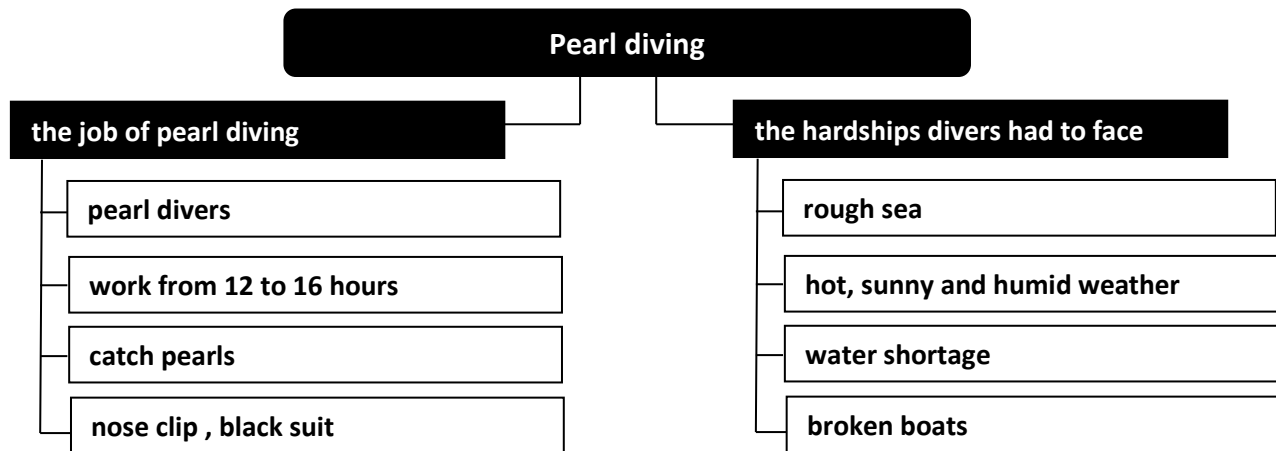

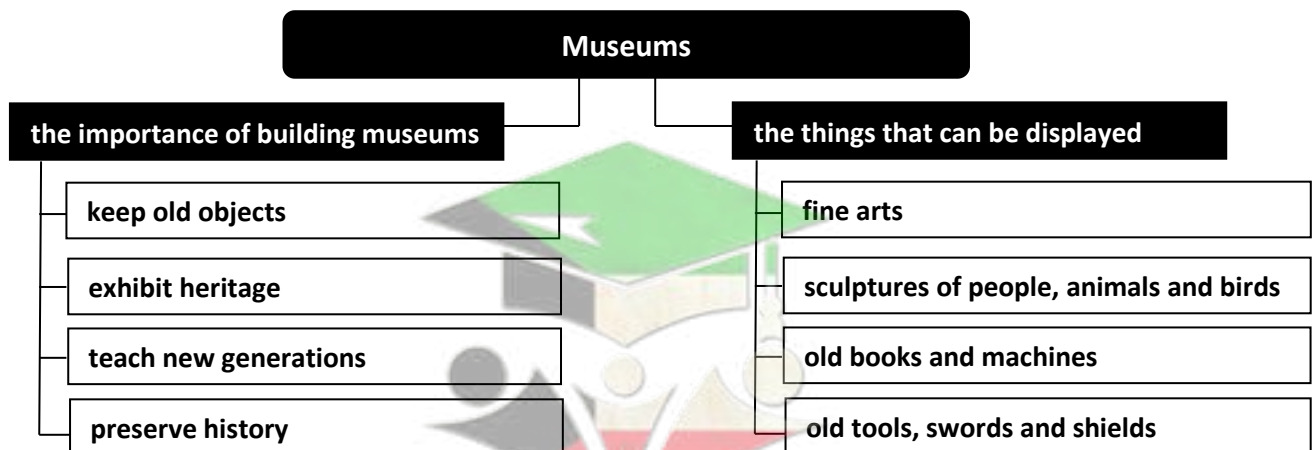
