



"It's an important piece of advice we often receive from the majority of doctors. Cigarette smoking represents a fearful enemy to man as it destroys health and bring about suffering and death. Doctors have proved that smokers are often attacked by cancer and heart diseases. Their lungs, throat and respiratory system are also attacked by cancer.
