had + past participle

الماضي التام عبارة عن (التصريف الثالث + had)

Use الاستخدام

- 1- An action that finished before another past action.

فعل انتهى قبل فعل آخر في الماضي، الفعل الأقدم نضعه في الماضي التام والفعل الأحدث نضعه في الماضي البسيط

ex: Ahmed had gone to work before his mother came back home.

- 2- An action happened before specific time in the past.

فعل حدث قبل وقت محدد في الماضي

ex: I had never played football before two weeks ago.

already / after / before / just / yet / for / since / until / by the time

يأتي بعدهم had + V3

NB: after - because - as soon as - but - till – until

before - by the time - when

Wish

1- In the present or in the future tense:

wish + past simple

ex: I don't have a car.

real

I wish I had a car.

not real

2- In the past tense: (regret):

wish + (had + V₃)

ex: I didn't play football yesterday.

real

I wish I had played football yesterday.

not real

The third conditional

قاعدة If الحالة الثالثة: تستخدم للتعبير عن حدث مستحيل أو ندم، أو تعبير عن أحداث تخيلية في الماضي وغير واقعية.

To describe a situation that didn't happen, and to imagine the result of this situation.

if + past perfect ... would + have + past participle

التصريف الثالث + would + have ... الماضي التام + if

ex: - If she had studied, she would have passed the exam

(but really, we know she didn't study and so she didn't pass).

- If I hadn't eaten so much, I wouldn't have felt sick

(but I did eat a lot, and so I did feel sick).

Cats and Egypt share a long and interesting history. Many cat experts believe that ancient Egyptians were the first to keep cats at home. At first, it was a practical matter as cats were brought in to protect homes from pests like rats and cockroaches. Eventually though, ancient Egyptians; especially the wealthy, started to adopt cats as pets.

Paintings on tombs and other buildings show spotted, slender cats, which are believed to be the first domestic cats. It is believed that these early Egyptian cats were the ancestors of the Egyptian Mau. This kind is not as well-known as other cat kinds.

Whoever killed a cat in ancient Egypt was put to death. Amazingly there were also laws preventing the exportation of cats. Ancient Egyptians loved cats and were very sad whenever any of the family cats died. Cats were kept and even mummified after death. Cat tombs have been discovered along the River Nile and cat mummies can be found in the tombs of many Egyptians.

Nowadays, cats are part of the homes of many people around the world. People love their company. Some can't live without having cats as friends. They take good care of them by providing food and taking them to doctors when necessary.
