Steve Jobs was born on February 24, 1955, in San Francisco, California. When he was a boy, he had a special hobby: he liked to takeapart televisions and put <u>them</u> back together again. He was a very good student in school and even skipped a grade. After he finished grade four, he went into grade six. In 1972, he graduated from high school at the age of 17. Then he began his studies in Reed College, in Portland, Oregon, but had to <u>drop</u> out after six months. Deciding to quit was not at all easy.

Few years later, Steve Jobs found a job as a video game designer at a company called Atari and two years later after that in 1976, when he was only twenty-one years, he created his own company – Apple Computer – with his friend, Steve Wozniak. Steve Jobs later got marriedin 1991 and had four children. Unfortunately, doctors discovered that he had cancer in 2003 and in 2011 he died at the age of 56.
