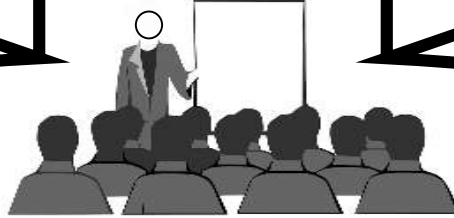

Steve Jobs was born on February 24, 1955, in San Francisco, California. When he was a boy, he had a special hobby: he liked to take apart televisions and put **them** back together again. He was a very good student in school and even skipped a grade. After he finished grade four, he went into grade six. In 1972, he graduated from high school at the age of 17. Then he began his studies in Reed College, in Portland, Oregon, but had to **drop out** after six months. Deciding to quit was not at all easy.

Few years later, Steve Jobs found a job as a video game designer at a company called Atari and two years later after that in 1976, when he was only twenty-one years, he created his own company – Apple Computer – with his friend, Steve Wozniak. Steve Jobs later got married in 1991 and had four children. Unfortunately, doctors discovered that he had cancer in 2003 and in 2011 he died at the age of 56.

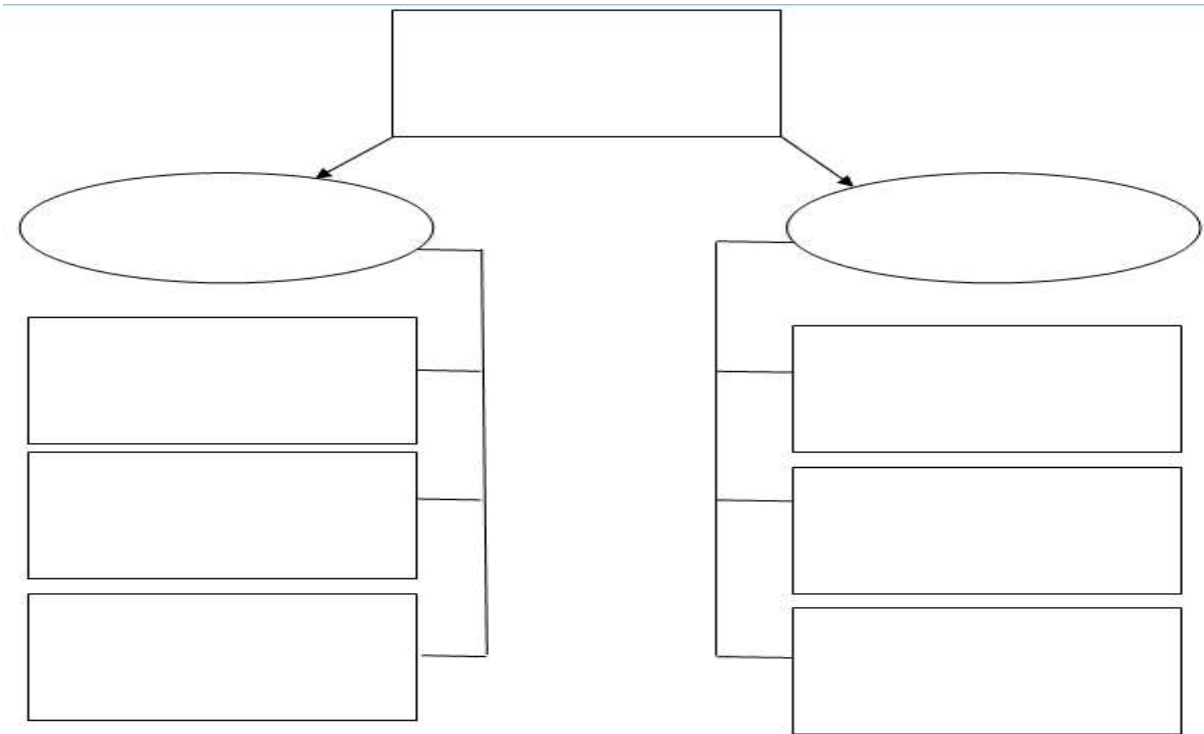

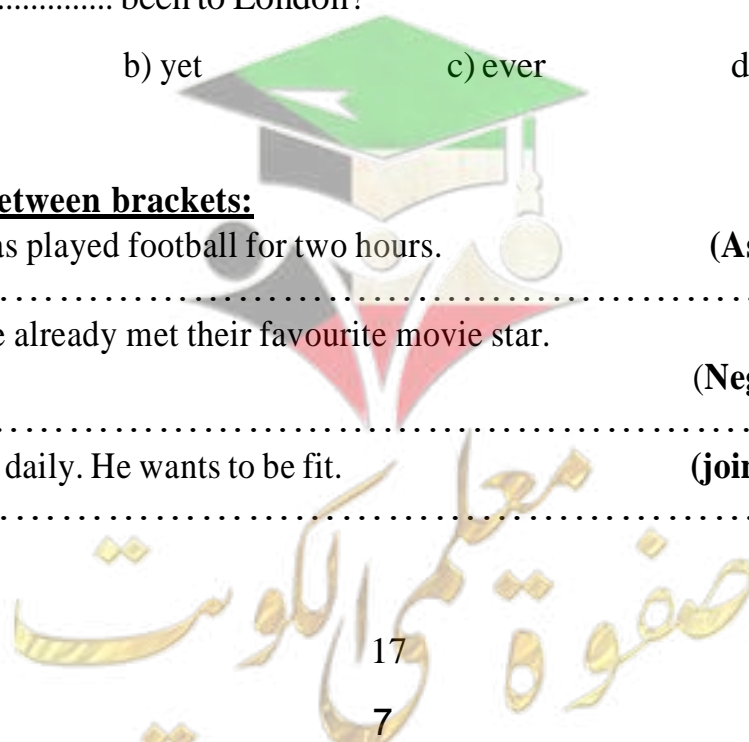

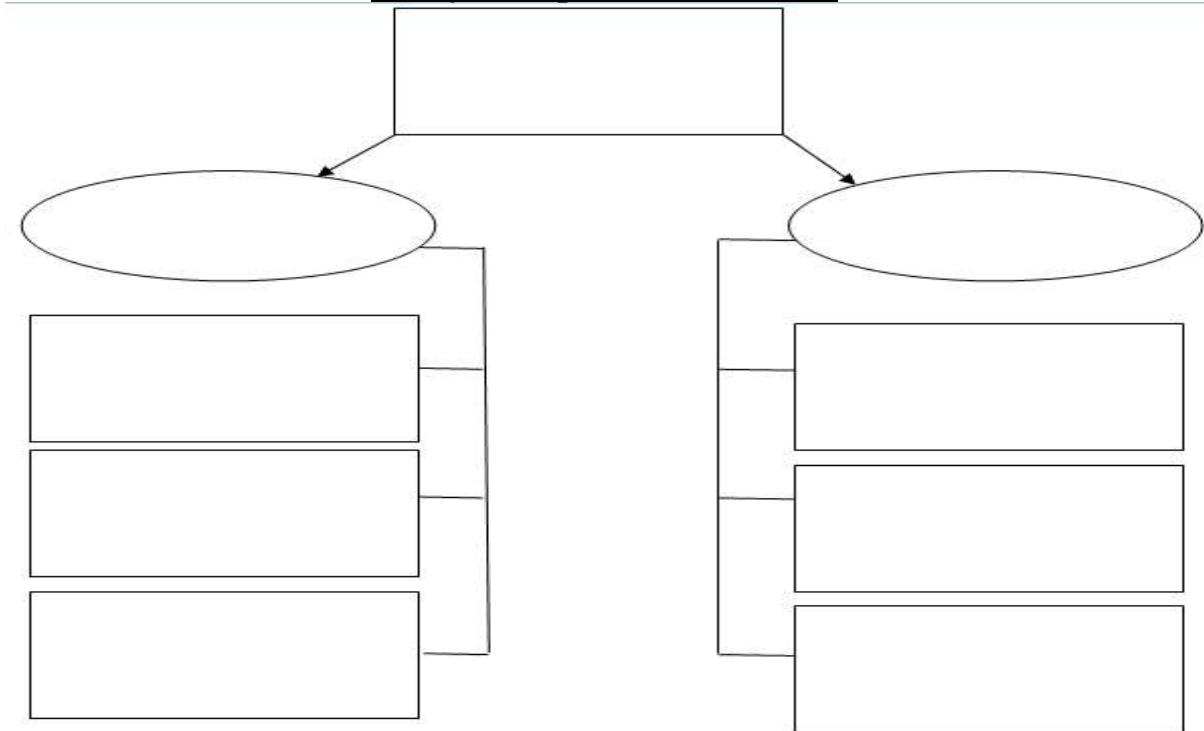

A rainforest is found in hot and humid parts of the world. It rains a lot there. Trees grow so closely that **their** branches and leaves slow the rain to reach the ground.



Rainforests are about 6% of Earth's surface. The largest rainforest and the most **enormous** is the Amazon in South America. It covers almost five million square kilometers. Rainforests provide us with many things. Half of the world's species of animals and plants live in the rainforests. Eighty percent 80% of the food we eat first grew there.
