

The first TV station was set up in 1928. It was in New York. Few people had TVs. The broadcasts were not meant to be watched. By the end of 1930, TVs were working well. America participated in the 1939 World's Fair. This was one of the biggest events ever. There were 200 small black and white TVs set up around the fair. The US President gave a speech over the TVs. Unfortunately, World War II was going on during this time. Factories were busy making guns and bombs. When the war was over, TV spread across the country.





Bethany Hamilton is an American professional surfer. On October 31, 2003, she and her friend's family were surfing in Hawaii. It was a pleasant day, and she was enjoying the sunshine and relaxing on her surfboard. Then suddenly, she was attacked by a tiger shark.



The shark bit off Bethany's arm. Surprisingly, she felt no pain at first. She later said she did not realise she had been bitten until she saw blood in the water. Bethany told her friend, Alana, that she had been attacked by a shark. Alana told her not to joke about something like that. But as Alana swam closer to Bethany, she knew that it was not a joke at all.

Fortunately, the shark disappeared in the open ocean. Alana and her father took Bethany back to the beach. Alana's father tried to stop the bleeding, but <u>it</u> kept increasing. Then they quickly took her to hospital where she was given the necessary treatment.

Bethany spent a week in the hospital, but within a month she was surfing again. She taught herself how to surf with one arm. The next year, she won the National Scholastic Surfer Association's top award which was her goal before her injury. Then, she won many other awards for her surfing, and in 2004, Bethany wrote a book about her experience. In 2011, the book was made into a movie. 





The history of perfume dates back to the ancient world. The Egyptians were the first to use it. Natural ingredients such as peppermint and roses are common in early perfumes. The



Egyptians invented materials such as glass and used glass perfume bottles to store their perfumes. **They** also used gold, hard stones and other materials to make their perfume containers.

The Greeks classified perfumes according to the part of plant they came from and kept records of their ingredients. Historians have also confirmed that Islamic, Chinese and Indian cultures had been using perfume as part of their religious ceremonies and social activities as well.

The 18<sup>th</sup> century brought a great advance in perfume industry with the invention of eau de Cologne- "water from Cologne". A young Italian invented it in the city of Cologne, Germany. This was a <u>blend</u> of various herbs and flowers and it was very refreshing.

In the 19<sup>th</sup> century there were many changes in Europe. Modern chemistry and advanced technology made it possible to create new ways of extracting perfumes from flowers. The biggest of all technological advances was the ability to create artificial ingredients in the place of natural perfume ingredients that were hard to find or very expensive.

Both men and women continue to enjoy wearing perfume and cologne. Perfume makes people feel good. Today, you may be in countries thousands of kilometers apart, and yet you can still be able to buy the same brands of perfume. Nowadays perfume is cleverly advertised, attractively bottled and sold at a price that many can afford.



Tomatoes are grown in all warm areas of the world.



Tomato plants generally have many spreading branches.

The leaves are hairy and have a strong smell. The flowers are yellow and grow in groups. Tomatoes can be round or oval or shaped like a pear. When they are ready, the fruit usually changes into red or yellow colour. The tomato **contains** many small seeds covered by a jellylike tissue. It has most of the tomato's vitamin C.

Despite the popularity of tomatoes, it was only 200 years ago, that they were thought to be toxic. When tomatoes came to Europe, people did not eat them. Doctors said that tomatoes would make people sick. Therefore, people just grew tomatoes because **they** looked nice. Now, people from all over the world eat tomatoes. 
