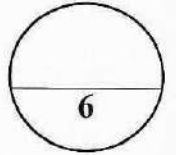

“What are the advantages of vitamin D?”

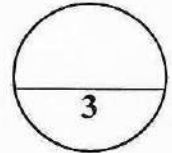
