Crocodiles are large animals that look like lizards but bigger in size. There are more than 10 types of crocodiles around the world. <u>They</u> also come in different sizes. These dangerous animals can be found in some parts of Asia, Africa and Australia. They live near swamps, lakes and rivers. They prefer living in hot and warm places.

Crocodiles spend most of their time in the water but they can also travel on land. The skin of crocodiles is very strong. The eyes and the ears of a crocodile are on its head. This will help it see and hear better when most of its body is under the water. It also helps it to surprise and catch animals to eat them.

Crocodiles mostly feed on fish, birds, turtles and other small animals by catching them and pulling them to the water. When a female crocodile is ready to lay eggs, it builds a small nest from mud and dead plants. Some types of crocodiles can lay more than 100 eggs. When they <u>hatch</u>, it stays with its babies for weeks to protect them.



Penguins are birds with black and white feathers. They have wings, but they can't fly like many other birds. Penguins live near salt water. They have special part in their bodies that pushes the salt out of their beaks. A group of penguins that lives together is called " a colony ". Penguins find their food in the water too. They eat fish, shrimps, squids and other forms of sea life which **they** catch with their beaks and swallow while swimming.

Most people think that penguins live in very cold places like Antaractica, but they also live on the coasts of south America, Africa and Australia. They spend half of their lives on land and the other half in the sea. The largest living penguin is called 'emperor penguin'. It's about 1.1 m tall and weighs 35 kg. The smallest penguin is the 'little blue penguin' also known as the "fairy" penguin which stands around 30-33 cm tall and 1.3 kg. Interestingly, penguins have no special fear of humans and often **approach** groups of people because humans don't usually hunt them. They have also been a good subject for films and cartoons. They are lovely birds.







Cobras change their skin around 4 to 6 times per year.




