











Bicycles are also the most energy-effective vehicle—a cyclist burns about 22 calories per km, while a vehicle burns 1,156 calories per km. Bicycles are used not only for transportation, but for fitness, competition, and touring as well. They come in some shapes and styles, including traditional bikes, racing bikes, and footing bicycles, as well as monocycles, tricycles, and pushbikes.

The 1860s proved to be an important decade for bicycle improvements with the inventions of metal-spoked wheels, solid rubber tires, and a lever-operated, four-speed gearshift. Around 1866 an unusual version of the Velocipede was created in England by James Stanley. It was called the Ordinary, or Penny Farthing, and it had a large front wheel and a small rear wheel. The Ordinaries were soon exported to the U.S. where a company began to manufacture them as well. These bicycles weighed about 32 kg and cost \$300—a large sum at the time.
