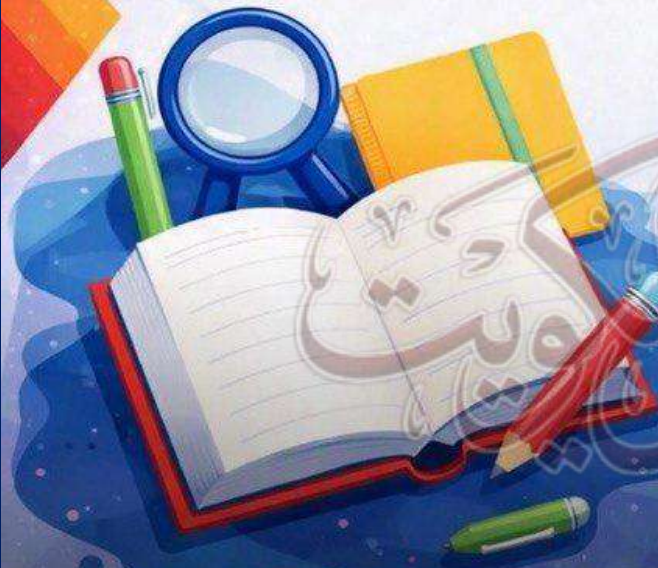

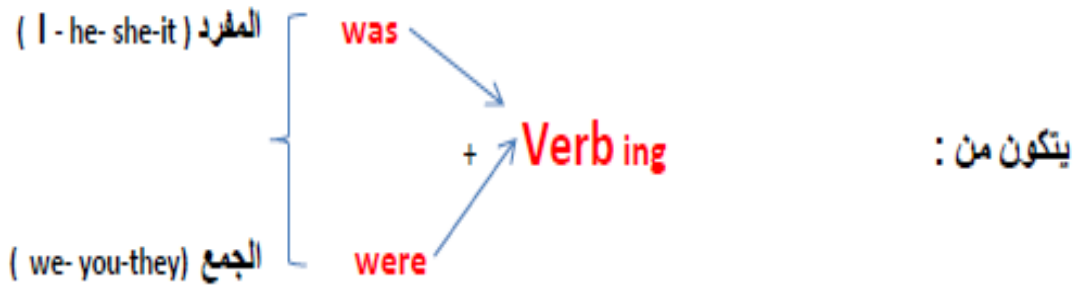

We must be safe when we go on an expedition. People should take enough food, water, and clothes. They need a first aid kit in case of small injuries. It is good to check the weather and tell someone about the trip. When people prepare well, they can stay safe and enjoy the expedition.

Expeditions are not always easy. The weather can be very hot or cold. The road may be long, and people can get tired or hungry. Sometimes there are wild animals or other dangers. If people stay calm and help each other, they can finish the expedition safely and feel proud.
