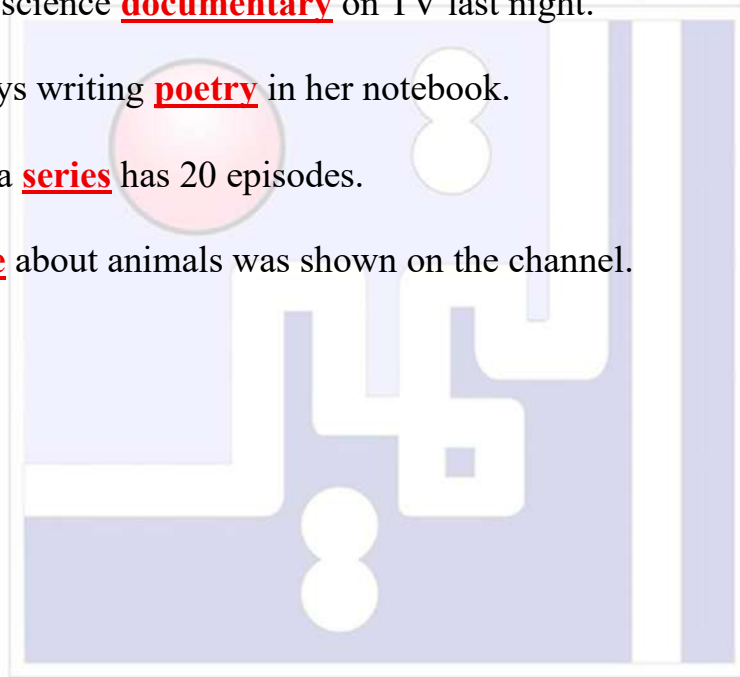

+ Affirmative: I **lived** in London.
+ Affirmative: She **lived** in Paris.
+ Affirmative: He **watched** a movie.
+ Affirmative: They **wanted** a holiday.

Past tense regular verbs end in -ed. ↑

There is only one form of each verb in the past simple tense.*

* The exception is **TO BE** which has two forms: was and were.

+ Affirmative: I **lived** in Spain.
- Negative: I **didn't live** in Spain.
+ Affirmative: He **watched** a movie.
- Negative: He **didn't watch** a movie.

* The base form of the infinitive = ~~to go~~, ~~to need~~, ~~to speak~~, ~~to live~~
The verb is not in the past tense in negative sentences. "Didn't" tells us it is a past tense sentence.

+ Affirmative: You **lived** in Italy.
? Question: **Did** you **live** in Italy?
+ Affirmative: She **watched** a movie.
? Question: **Did** she **watch** a movie?

* The base form of the infinitive = ~~to go~~, ~~to need~~, ~~to speak~~, ~~to live~~
The verb is not in the past tense in questions. "Did" tells us we are asking a past tense question.

Unit 1 Used to + infinitive':

We use this expression to talk about habits or repeated actions in the past which we don't do in the present. For example:

- 1- I used to have long hair (but now I have short hair).
- 2- He used to smoke (but now he doesn't smoke).
- 3- They used to live in India (but now they live in Germany).

Watch out! With the negative and the question it's 'use' and not 'used':

Did you use to be a teacher?

Did he use to study French?

She didn't use to like chocolate, but she does now.

I didn't use to want to have a nice house.
