Word Builders: Prefixes & Suffixes (un-, re-, -less, -ment)

a. Read and Learn



- **Prefix:** a group of letters added to the **beginning** of a word to change its meaning. (**un** + happy = **unhappy**)
- **Suffix:** a group of letters added to the **end** of a word to change its form or meaning. (help + **ful** = **helpful**)

Examples:

Base Word	Form	Affix	New Word	Form	Meaning of New Word
healthy	adjective	prefix (un-)	unhealthy	adjective	not healthy
play	verb	prefix (re-)	replay	verb	play again
care	verb/ noun	suffix (-less)	careless	adjective	without care
move	verb	suffix (-ment)	movement	noun	the act of moving
