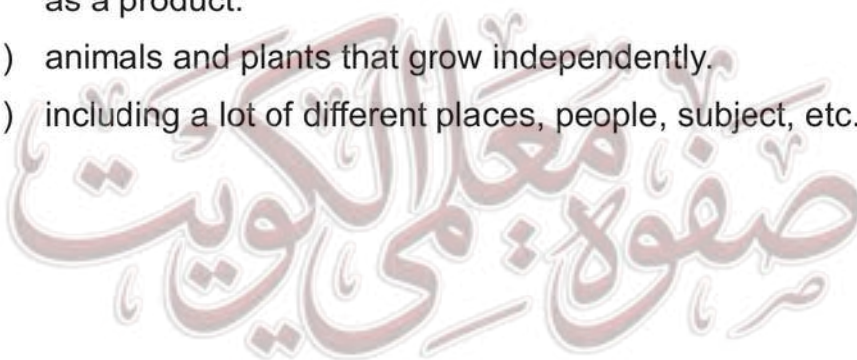

Two Words, One Meaning: Hyphenated Adjectives

- A **hyphenated compound adjective** is made of two words joined with a hyphen (-) that describe a noun. It usually comes **before the noun**.

Compound Adjective	Meaning	Example Sentence
well-known	famous or widely recognised	He is a well-known scientist.
high-risk	very dangerous	Firefighting is a high-risk job.
full-time	working all week	She has a full-time job.
